Macro or aggregated data are data that have been averaged, totaled or otherwise derived from the individual level data found in the survey datasets.



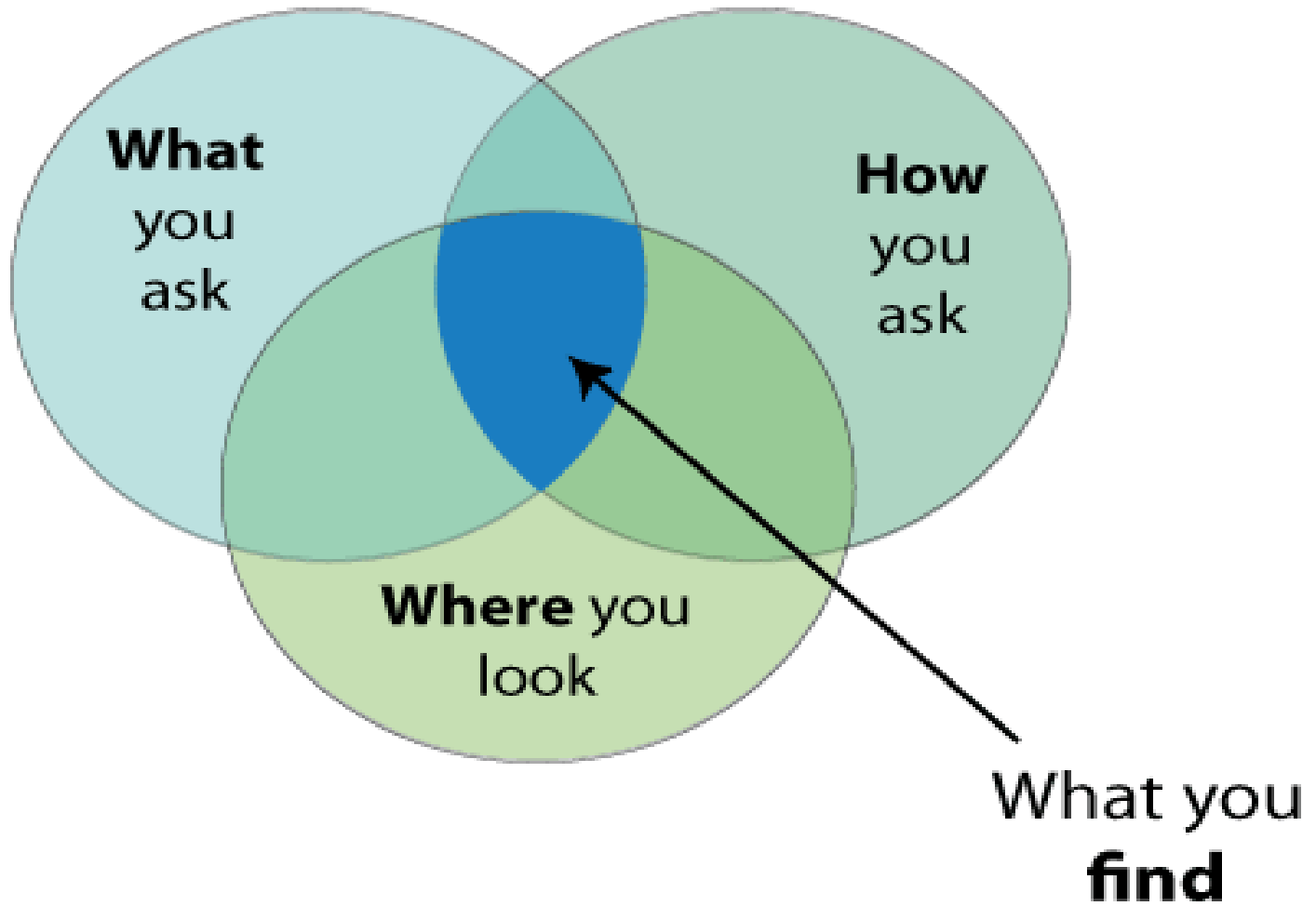

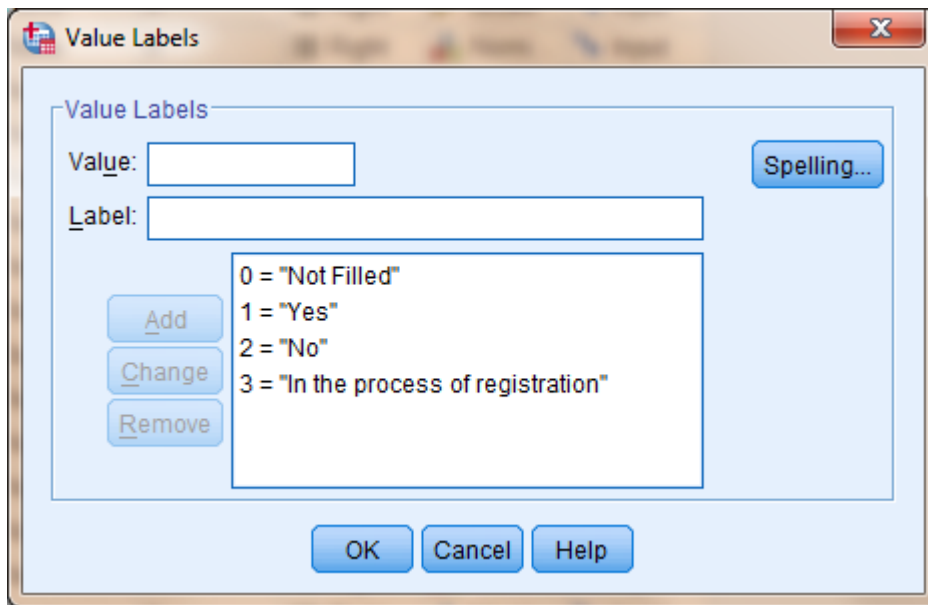
Example

- **To be considered as formal – a business should be registered or else it is considered as informal**
